Service Road Safety – School Crossing Patrols - Body Worn Cameras

Privacy notice Last updated: December 2024

The following privacy notice applies to the School Crossing Patrol Services use of Body Worn Cameras for School Crossing Patrols at crossing sites, provided by Hunnyhill Primary School. It should be read in addition to the School's overall Privacy Notice.

Purpose for processing Hunnyhill School makes use of Surveillance Camera Technologies to achieve the following purposes,

- To deter and report anti-social behaviour, abuse and drivers who drivethrough an active crossing patrol,
- Protect the Health & Safety of staff and users of the crossing,
- Prevent and detect crime including anti-social or aggressive behaviour towards WCC staff, the public and assist in the identification and potential prosecution of offenders.

Personal information collected and lawful basis

We may process personal information this may include, but is not limited to:

• Vehicle registrations

The lawful basis for processing personal information is:

Public task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of an official authority

We may also process some sensitive (special category) information, which can include but is not limited to:

- Visual images
- Audio

The lawful basis for processing this sensitive (special category) data is:

- Substantial public interest on basis of UK law
- Establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims

Who we may share your information with

Occasionally, we may need to share the personal information you have given to us, or we've collected about you with partner organisations. These include but are not limited to:

- Driver Vehicle Licencing Authority (DVLA) for vehicle owner details
- Police where a criminal offence / abusive behaviour may have taken place
- IOWCC and External Solicitors
- IOWCC and External Insurance / Claims
- Crown Prosecution Service

We have specific data sharing agreements in place with local agencies and sometimes the law requires that we may have to pass your details on to a third party, for example, to prevent crime.

Information will only ever be shared when it is strictly necessary to help us provide effective services and you may have the right to refuse. We will not pass it onto any other parties unless required to do so by law or in all reasonable circumstances the disclosure is fair and warranted for the purposes of processing or subject to a legal data protection exemption.

How long we will hold your information

All information captured by a Body Worn Camera, which is deemed by the School Crossing Patrol Service to be non-evidential, will be automatically deleted after 30 days.

Images used for evidence will be retained for 6 years after the completion of the case and any appeals.

Your information rights
